

### BELGRADE, SARAJEVO, MOSTAR & DUBROVNIK BY PRIVATE CAR







- Day 1: Upon arrival in Belgrade, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is free to relax or to begin exploring the Serbia's vibrant capital. (B)
- Day 2: In the morning, enjoy a **private tour** to see the quarter known as Dedinje, learn about Serbia's two royal dynasties at the Royal White Palace, pedestrian street Knez Mihailova, The National Theatre, Serbian Patriarchy building, The Cathedral Church, including a visit to the Kalemegdan fortress with its ramparts and a superb view over the confluence of the Sava and Danube rivers. **(B)**
- Day 3: Today, we **travel to Bosnia's capital**, Sarajevo, the rest of the day is free to explore and admire the blend of architectural styles. **(B)**
- Day 4: Today learn about Sarajevo's unique history and empires. See all the city highlights; Stroll through the scenic Ottoman-era Bascarsija Square & the Husref bay's mosque. Admire the Austro-Hungarian architecture that splashes the city. See & learn more about the famous Latin Bridge and the beginning of World War I and visit to the war Tunnel museum Tunnel of Hope. (B)
- Day 5: A scenic road will bring you to the **Adriatic coast**, with a stop for a private walking **tour of Mostar**, see the city highlights, such as the famous "Old Bridge" built by the ottoman Empire in the 15th century, pass by the old bazaar, and visit the Mosque and typical Turkish house. - **Day 1:** Upon arrival at Sofia airport you will be met and assisted by your tour-guide, then transferred to your central Sofia hotel. The rest of the day free.
- Day 2: After breakfast a walking tour of ancient and contemporary Sofia. Afternoon free for individual activities. Welcome dinner at a traditional restaurant. (B,D)
- Day 3: Some free time in the morning. Then in the outskirts of Sofia, we'll visit the UNESCO listed 12th cent. **Boyana Church**. Later, a 1 ¾ hour drive southeast to Plovdiv. In the afternoon, a walking tour of the Old town and end the day with a dinner at a traditional restaurant with live entertainment. (B,D)

#### Day 1.

Upon arrival private transfer to the Hotel. **Accomodation in Bucharest.**



### GRAND BALKAN TOUR



#### Day 1.

Depending on the time of arrival in Tirana, we may do a short city tour. In the evening, we'll have and optional **dinner at a traditional restaurant** and then explore the nightlife of Tirana, walking in the ex-block area known as "forbidden town" where the villas of the communist leaders are still standing next to trendy boutiques, expensive jeweler shops and lively local pubs. Overnight in Tirana.

#### Day 2.

After breakfast, **drive to Kruja**-known for Albania's national hero Skanderbeg. Visit the Castle and the Skanderbeg and Ethnographic Museums. Explore the Old Bazaar and continue to Durres, the ancient Greco-Roman port city "Dyrrachium". The visit to the town includes the Byzantine city walls, the Roman Amphitheater and the Archeological Museum. Drive back to Tirana for overnight. **(B)** 

#### Day 3.

Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, proceed to the ancient **Greek settlement of Apolonia**, founded in 588 BC. Continue to Ardenica with its medieval monastery surrounded by stonewalls. Visit Mary Church and St. Triadha Chapel. Drive to Berat - another "Museum City" also known as "the city of thousand windows". You will see the painted Mosque of the Bachelors and the Tekke of the Halvetis complex with its beautiful portico. End your day with a visit to Onuphri Icon Museum. Overnight in Berat.**(B)** 

#### DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

#### Day. 4

After breakfast depart to visit Pogradec. Stop at Elbasa to see the beautiful Ottoman walls. **Arrive at Lake Ohrid**, one of the deepest freshwater lakes in Europe - home to a great number of fish and birds found nowhere else in the world. **Enjoy an optional lunch at a local restaurant** in Drilon, decorated with willow trees and streams flowing down to the lake. Nice spot not far from Ohrid Lake which has been a preferred holiday destination for ex-dictator, Hoxha. Overnight in Pogradec. **(B)** 

After breakfast, visit Drillon National Park on the shores of Lake Ohrid. **Cross the border into Macedonia** and visit the Monastery of St. Naum. Continue to the other side of the lake to Ohrid. Visit the 11th century castle and other important ancient churches and schools. Orthodox Byzantine monks brought Christianity to Ohrid in the 10th century from Greece through the efforts of St. Cyril and Methodios, who crafted the Cyrillic alphabet. Overnight in Ohrid. **(B)** 

#### Day 6.

Skopje was an important city for the Ottomans from the end of the 14th century. The Skopje of today retains that influence and is a thriving modern city. The largest Turkish bath in the Balkans is located here and is now an Art Museum. We will visit the Turkish Bazaar and the National Museum. Overnight in Skopje. (B)

#### Day 7.

After breakfast, **drive to Prizren in Kosovo**, a true open air museum and one of the most beautiful towns in Kosovo, situated on the slopes of the Sharr Mountains and on the banks of the river Bistrica. The craftsmen of Prizren are well known for their beautiful gold and silver items. Optional dinner and overnight in Prizren. **(B)** 

#### Day 8.

After breakfast, tour the old part of Prizren. Then cross the border to Albania to visit Shkodra. It has been an important city for over 2,000 years. Once part of the Venetian Empire, Italian influence is evident everywhere. Visit Rozafa Castle. **Optional dinner and overnight in Shkodra.** (B)

#### Day 9.

Tour the old town of Shkodra, then cross the border to Montenegro. **Drive to the capital Podgorica for a short city tour**. Continue to Budva, one of the oldest settlements on the Adriatic, now the most famous summer resort of Montenegro. Visit Old Town and listen to legends about the Theban King Cadmus and the development of the city from the Greek period to turbulent Middle Ages and the devastating 1976 earthquake. Overnight in Budva. **(B)** 

#### Day 10.

Breakfast at the hotel. Afterwards, private car transfer to the Dubrovnik airport via the Scenic Kotor Bay. This is the end of your tour. **(B)**

#### Day 1.

**Arrive in Budapest, Hungary**. At the airport, an English speaking guide will meet you along with a chauffeur driven car to **transfer you to your deluxe hotel**. The balance of the day is at leisure. Overnight in Budapest, deluxe hotel of your choice. **(B)** 

#### Day 2.

After breakfast, private guided sightseeing tour of Budapest, including the Royal Castle, Matthias Church, Fisherman's Bastion, the Parliament, St. Stephen's Basilica and Hero's Square. The morning sightseeing tour will feature Wawel Hill with its impressive Royal Castle and Wawel Royal Cathedral - the place of the cult of St. Stanislaw and St. Jadwiga, Queen of Poland. Its 18 chapels are true architectural masterpieces. The giant bell, Zygmunt from 1520 ranks with the world's largest. This is the place, where Polish kings were crowned and buried. Continue the tour with the walk to the Old Town with its restored Main Square of magnificent houses and palaces. There, you stop at St. Mary's Basilica, where to see the magnificent wooden altar by Wit Stwosz. In the middle of the square is the Cloth Hall built before 1349, but renovated in the 16th century with many shopping stalls inside.

Following lunch on own we will driver to Wieliczka for visiting the Salt Mine\*\*\* - an impressive and unique underground world full of saline lakes, majestic timber constructions, great chambers, galleries and unique Salt Works created by many generations of Polish miners and operated since 13th century. The tour leads through almost 3 kilometres of meandering corridors, at the depth of 135 meters – the part, which has been worked from 17th to 19th century.

Dinner with a folkloric show will be served at a local restaurant in Wieliczka, before we drive back to Krakow.

#### DAY 7 Friday • KRAKOW - LOWICZ - TORUN

#### (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, we leave for Torun. On the way, we will stop in Lowicz, a typical Mazovian town famous for folk art: colorful costumes and beautiful paper cut-outs. You will be invited for a homehosted lunch by a local family, whose charming cottage is located at the foot of the former Lowicz Castle. You will be welcomed in a typical Polish way, with bread & salt, and enjoy your meal served by the young married couple in their lovely house. You will have time to talk about their day to day life and have your dessert in a beautiful garden. We continue to Torun, where the balance of the day is at leisure.

Important notes referring Wieliczka Salt Mine:

There are total 800 steps to climb of which 350 at the beginning taking you down into the mine. This 350 steps will be changed into lift service [the service depends on lift technical conditions].

Make sure to put on comfortable shoes.

The visit is always conducted under the supervision of local guide (the Miner) – obligatory.

The temperature underground falls within the range of 17-18°C, regardless of the season. We advise you to dress appropriately taking the above in mind.

#### (Breakfast)

In the morning we see the highlights of Torun. It is the birthplace of Nicolaus Copernicus and considered one of the most magnificent historic cities of Poland. Its Old Town has been included in UNESCO's list for its impressive 13th century Town Hall, superb churches and historic streets preserving Torun's past glory. Following lunch on own, we drive to Gdansk. Upon arrival, we take a brief walk through the town's Old Town.

#### DAY 9 Sunday • GDANSK - GDYNIA - SOPOT - OLIWA - GDANSK

#### (Breakfast)

After breakfast we drive to Gdynia, youngest of the tri-city complex, which also includes Sopot the famous and fashionable seaside resort. Here you can still see the oldest and longest wooden pier in Europe. We will also visit Oliwa Cathedral famous for one-of-a-kind pipe organs.

The balance of the day is free to give you time for shopping Baltic arts and crafts, including unique amber jewelry and trinkets.



DAY 10 Monday • GDANSK - WARSAW

#### (Breakfast, Lunch)

Today we tour Gdansk in depth. We start from the Upland Gate - a fragment of the city's former fortifications and one of its main gates. Just behind it, we pass by a baked-brick construction consisting of the Prison Tower and the Torture House - relics of the 15th century Gothic defense walls. The Golden Gate, situated next to the Prison Tower, opens onto Long Market - a magnificent street, with grand mansions decorated with late Renaissance and Baroque facades. A real feast for the eyes!!! It is here that the richest burghers of Gdansk once lived. Next, we come upon the Main Town and the Artus Court - a building used for Hanseatic League meetings. It is renowned as the most beautiful court among all of Europe's Hanseatic cities. Just behind it stands the tower of St. Mary's Basilica, a part of the most precious and largest red-brick Gothic churches in Gdansk.
